Buttercups - Tunday 15th July 1-2pm



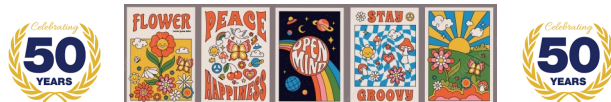
Last full day of school is Thursday 17th July at normal time
